The United Way also provides Emergency Food Stamps and Disaster Unemployment Insurance. Please see the Disaster Relief Services' side bar on the right for more information on how to qualify for two months worth of food stamps and Disaster Unemployment Insurance.

- Proof of residence
- Drivers license
- Must be able to answer questions about bank account balances and other assets.

DISASTER UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE

To claim this protection, a worker must file by October 15. To file for disaster-related unemployment assistance, log on to www.texasworkforce.org or call TWC from Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Central Time, at 1-800/939-6631.
