LITE-UP TEXAS PROGRAM



The LITE-UP TEXAS program is designed to help qualified low-income individuals reduce the monthly cost of electric service. You may qualify to receive a discount on your electric bill for the months of May-August of 2009 if you receive Food Stamps or Medicaid, or if your household income is at or below 125 percent of the federal poverty guidelines (\$13,538 for a family of 1, \$18,213 for a family of 2, \$22,888 for a family of 3, or \$27,563 for a family of 4.)
