## VETERANS HOME CARE PROVIDERS – VET ASSIST PROGRAM

Do you know a veteran that needs help with housekeeping, hygiene, assistance devices, at risk for a fall, depression, or other medical or health problems? The Vet Assistance Program can help provide caregiver services for veterans. To qualify you must have completed:

- Military services with one day in active wartime
- 90 days total of active duty
- Honorable discharge

The amount of hours of care provided depends on the status of the individual:

- Married veteran – 20 hours
- Single veteran – 16 hours
- Surviving spouse (non-divorced) – 11 hours

To qualify, you must also demonstrate a medical need, such as not being able to adequately care for yourself, as well as income limitations.
