GARBAGE DISPOSAL TIPS

- Run your disposal regularly – even if you are not grinding up food, run the water and the disposal to get rid of residual food, and to keep the parts running smoothly.
- Use cold water – cold water hardens the food you are putting down the disposal, making it easier for your disposal to grind up and get rid of the food waste. Hot water can cause food waste to clog your drains or cling to other surfaces.
- Run your disposal longer – once the food is gone, continue to run your disposal for about a minute, to ensure nothing remains behind or clogs pipes or your disposal.
- Cut waste into small pieces – by doing this and only putting in a few pieces at a time, there is less stress on your disposal and it's motor.
- Grind citrus fruit – tossing the peel from a lemon, lime or orange into your disposal and grinding the peel can clear excess waste and eliminate odors.

DO NOT EVER PUT THE FOLLOWING DOWN YOUR DISPOSAL:

- Grease or oil – collect excess in a can and throw in the trash when it has solidified
- Potato peels or other starchy foods – these can cling to the sides of the disposal making it harder to flush out the drain pipe
- Glass, plastic, metal or paper – these can jam your disposal or dull the blades
- Big bones, pits, or seeds – these can damage the blades or motor, and get stuck in the drain pipes
- Expandable foods – these include foods such as rice and pasta, which can expand and clog the disposal and drain pipes
