# **CSFP (CHEESE BOX) PROGRAM BY SA FOOD BANK**

The Commodity Supplement Food Program is a food assistance program for adults who are age 60 and older. Food is delivered once a month on the second Friday. It is on a first-come, first-served basis, and a photo ID is needed for pickup. If you cannot pick up your box, a proxy may be added to your application to pick up for you. In order to participate, you must be registered. At the moment, the Food Bank CSFP Program has reached capacity and they are no longer accepting new applications.
